Encompassing a wide range of options, such as circulating air, massaging jets, and soothing light, the system tubs are also available with a short lead time thanks to Duravit's in-house assembly facility right at home in Georgia.

The full range of Duravit system bathtubs can be incorporated with whirltub features consisting of jets with varying massage effects and functions to increase relaxation. Each bathtub is composed of high-quality sanitary acrylic that meshes with the bubbling sensation of a built-in whirl system to create a unique soothing experience. A fan moves a mixture of air and water through the sides of the bathtub to create small bubbles which gently, or powerfully, massage the calves, thighs, and back. These bubbles stimulate the tissue under the skin to improve circulation, while water massage jets alleviate muscular pain and tension. All system bathtubs are extremely beneficial for those suffering from rheumatism, back pain, or sleep disorder, as the circulation and relaxation fosters natural healing processes.

Additional options to the Duravit system bathtubs include: LED lights, an in-line heater, an ozone module, waterproof speakers, and a practical floating remote control. The remote is at once waterproof and intuitive, allowing the floating remote to be used to operate all functions. Optional colored light and whirltub programs can also be combined for use with the remote.
