

**CABINETS:**

The cabinet door and interior are constructed of mirror and aluminum. Use only a damp cloth to clean. Spray the cloth, not the mirror when cleaning. Ammonia or vinegar-based cleaners can damage mirrors. A 50/50 solution of water and isopropyl alcohol is recommended for cleaning stubborn stains. **USE NO ABRASIVE CLEANERS ON ANY PART OF THE CABINET.** The gasket can be cleaned with a mild non-abrasive cleaner such as Bon Ami or Soft Scrub.

WALL MIRRORS:

Use only a damp cloth to clean. Spray the cloth, not the mirror when cleaning. Ammonia or vinegar-based cleaners can damage mirrors. A 50/50 solution of water and isopropyl alcohol is recommended for cleaning stubborn stains. **USE NO ABRASIVE CLEANERS ON ANY PART OF THE MIRROR.**

VERTICAL FLUORESCENT LIGHT KIT AND SCONCES:

Wipe your fixtures with a soft dry cloth. Use a damp cloth when needed. **DO NOT USE ANY ABRASIVE CLEANERS ON YOUR LIGHT FIXTURES.**

REFLECTION LIGHT KITS:

The fronts and the sides of the light kit are constructed of mirrored glass and anodized aluminum. Use only a damp cloth to clean. Ammonia or vinegar-based cleaners can damage mirrors. A 50/50 solution of water and isopropyl alcohol is recommended for cleaning stubborn stains on the mirrored fronts. A mild detergent may be used on the surfaces. When cleaning, spray the cloth; not the light, mirror, or surrounding surfaces. **DO NOT USE ABRASIVE CLEANERS ON ANY PART OF THE LIGHT.**

SINK AND VANITY CONSOLES:

Clean all surfaces, other than the mirror, with non-abrasive cleaners such as Lysol "DIRECT." Please see above for instructions on how to clean the mirror.

WOOD FRAME SURROUNDS AND FRAMED DOORS:

Wipe the wood frame surrounds and framed doors with a soft damp towel. Furniture polish, such as Pledge, can also be used on the wood frames. Please be advised not to use the polish on the mirrors.
